

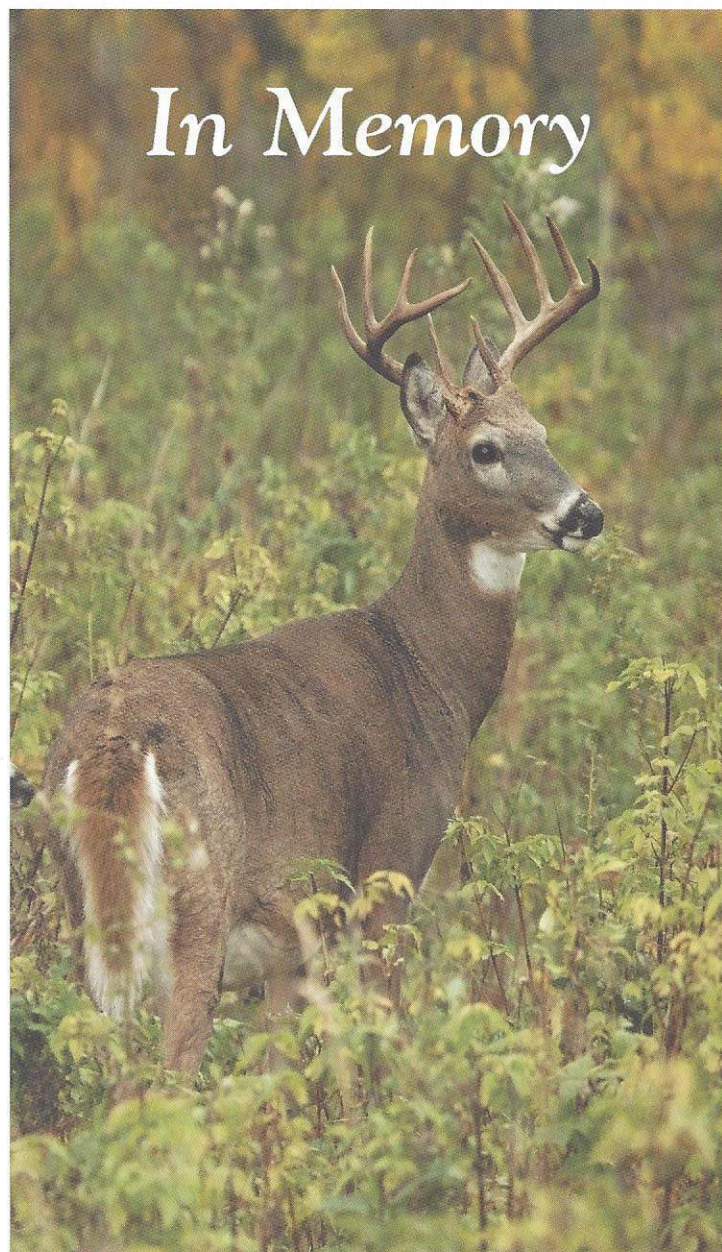
Mark Anthony Mudgett, age 52, passed away on Monday, December 17, 2018, at Sanford Health, Fargo, ND.
