Wolves). Maryann was active on the TCC Board and Four Winds Tribal Education Board.

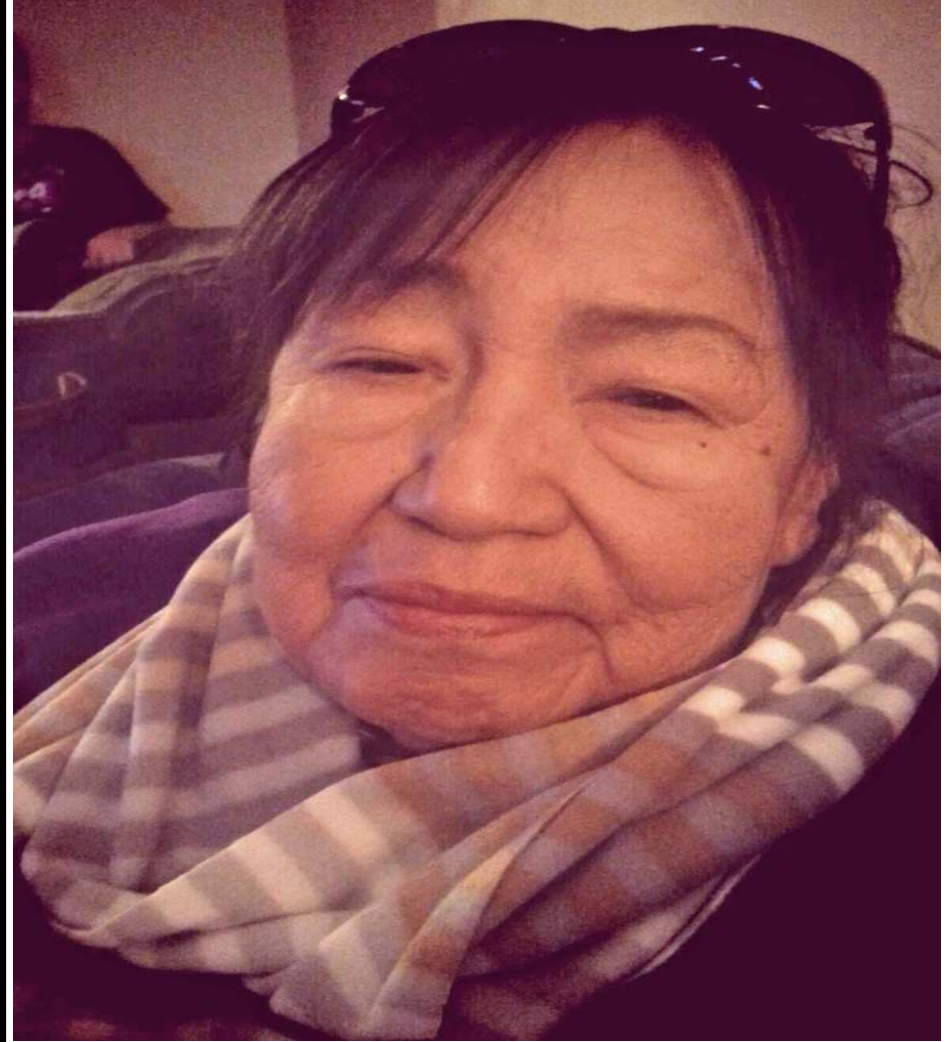
