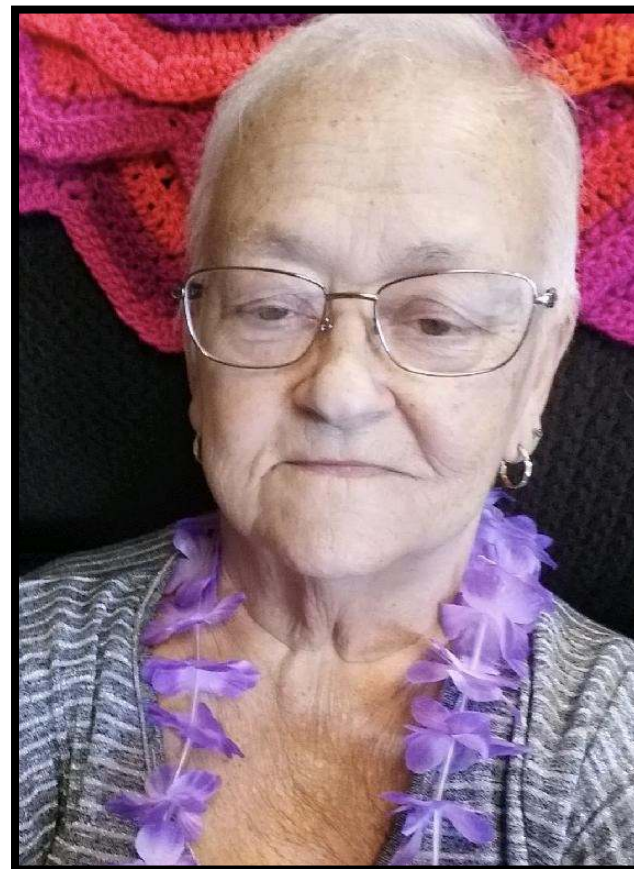
She was preceded in death by her parents Martha and Clarence Glancy and her little sister Ginny Glancy.
