

Juleon "Reno" Littleghost, age 35, of Fort Totten, ND, died Sunday, January 1, 2023, at his home in Fort Totten.

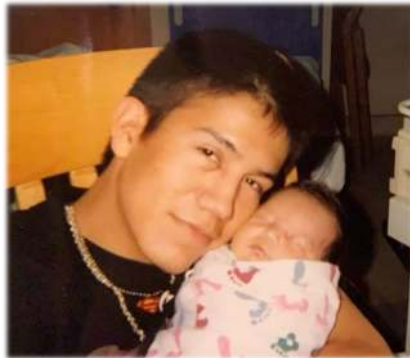
