

Sylvester Littlewind Sr., 62, passed away on Saturday, November 11, 2023, at his home, Fort Totten, ND.

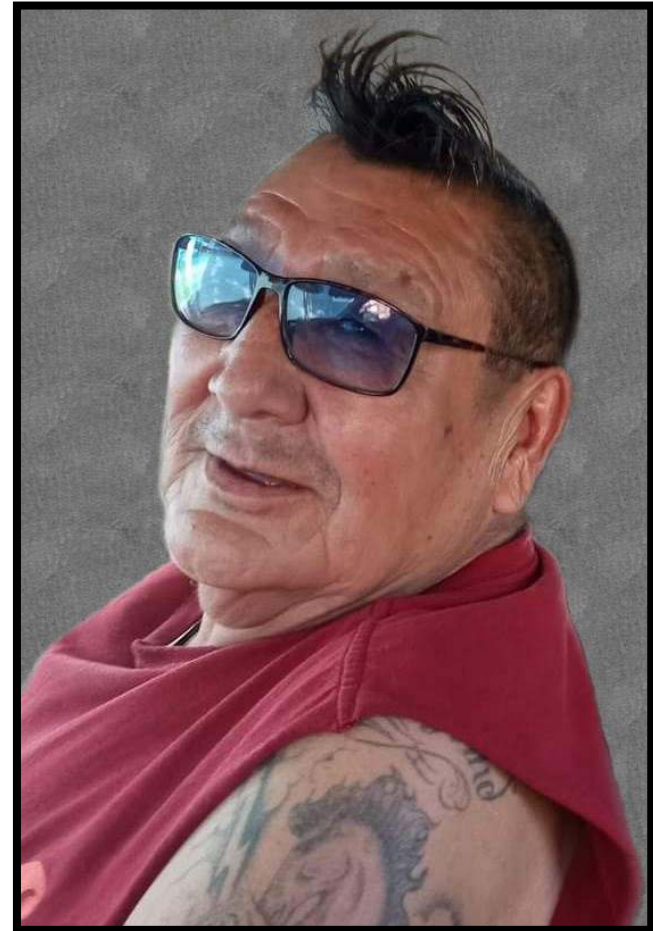
