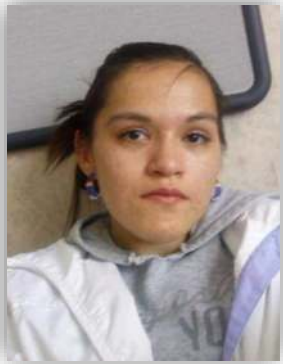

precious by her *touch,*

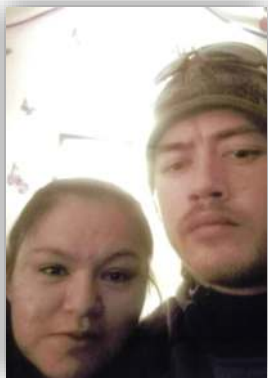


Her selfless love lives on in each of us,
