Terry was born July 16, 1963, in Devils Lake, ND, to Francis Rattlingtail and Angeline (Alberts) Dunn. He went to grade school in Fort Totten, ND, then moved to Bismarck, ND, with family. They moved back to Fort Totten in the 70s where he started the rodeo circuit. Terry started his rodeo career at the age of 13 and ended at age 42. In 1983, he received his GED and entered the National Guard at that time. He then relocated to San Diego, CA for a few years, then returned home to Fort Totten where he lived and continued on the rodeo circuit. Terry was featured in the movie, "The Last of the Mohicans". Terry furthered his career at DTI, then went on to Sioux Manufacturing. He also became a driver for Tribal Health, and at the time of his death he was security at Spirit Lake Housing. In 2015, he met his loving wife, Annalee Makes Good, and they were united in marriage on Sept 7, 2018. They made their home at St. Michael.

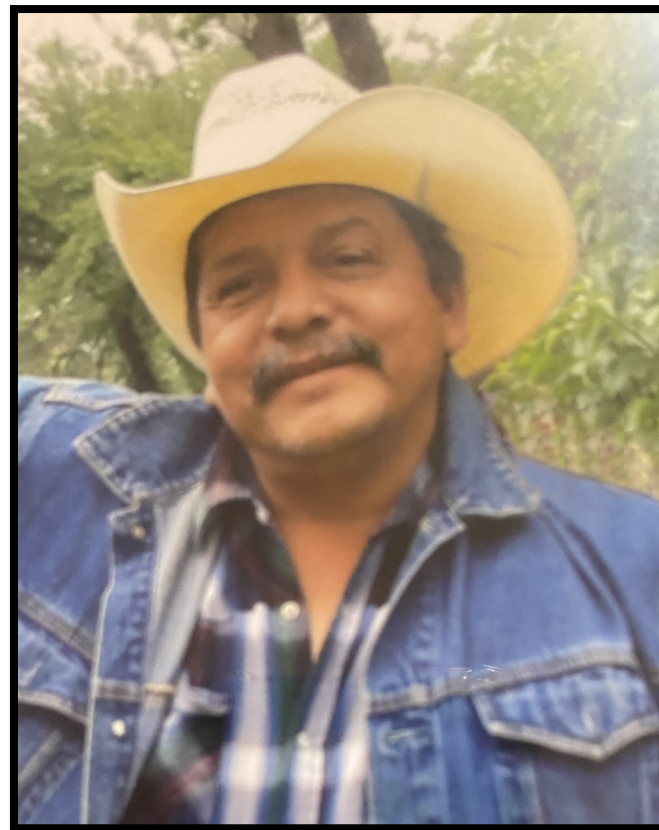
