

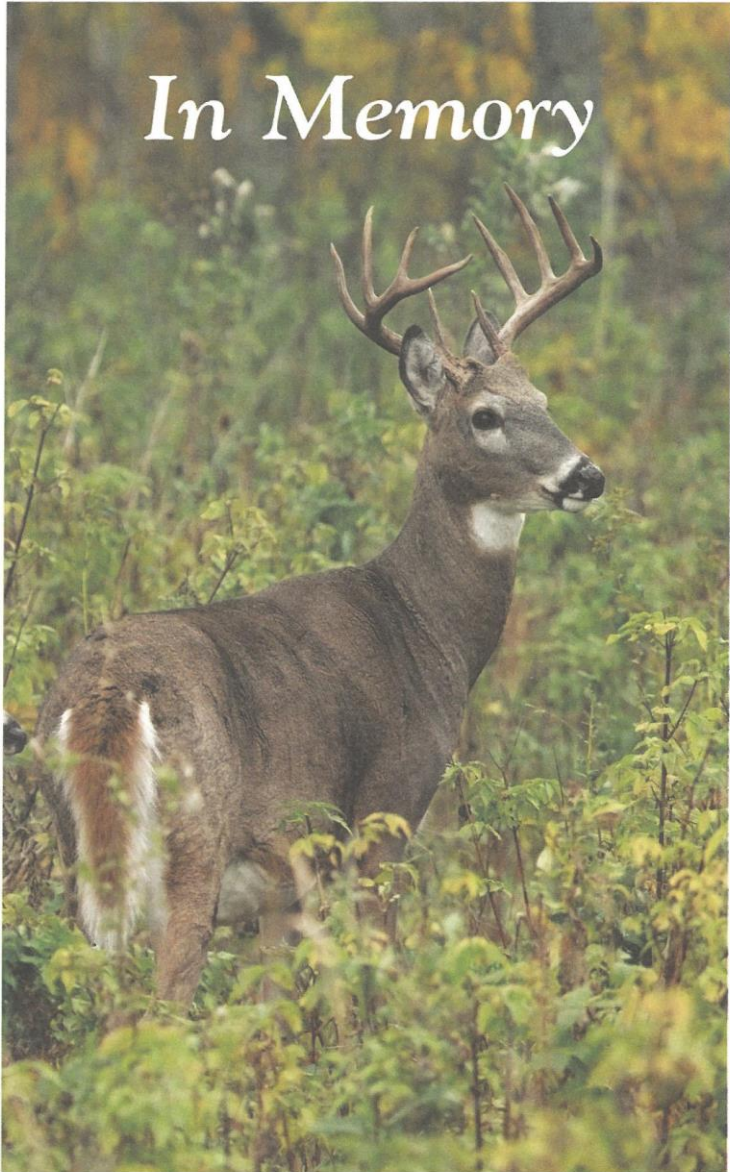
Lynnell Stebner, age 75, of Woodworth, ND, passed away on Saturday, April 26, 2025, at his home under the care of Hospice.
