May he rest in peace, knowing his life was well lived and his legacy continues through all who loved him.

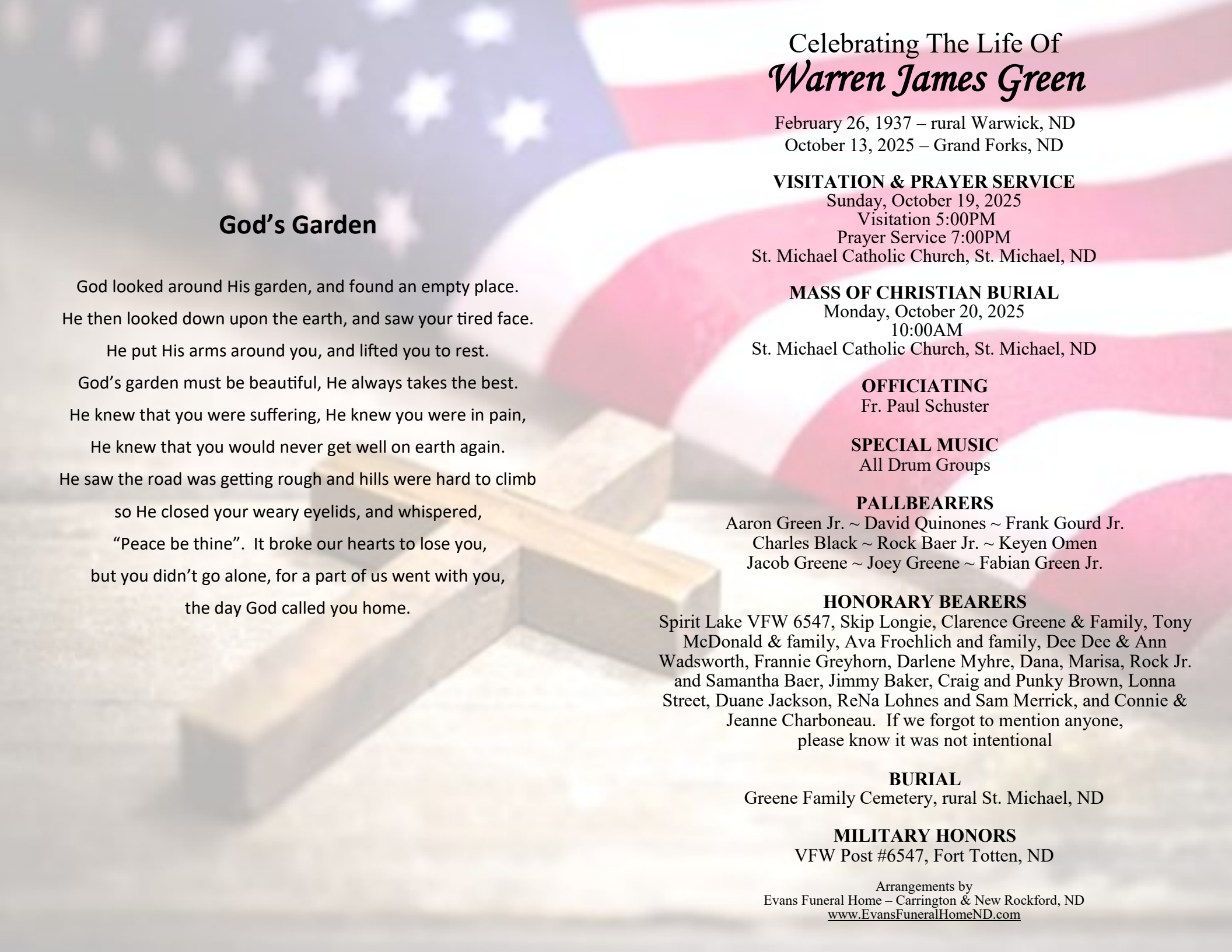
