Richard is survived by his siblings: Janice, Mary, Loretta, Jennifer, and Ben Dubois. And Many Nieces and Nephews.

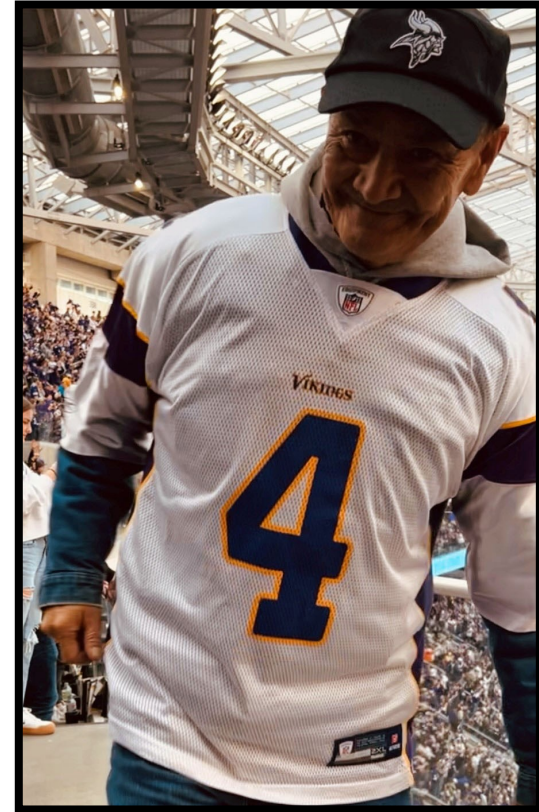

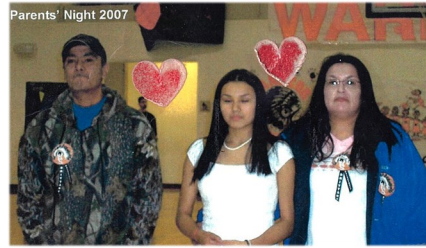
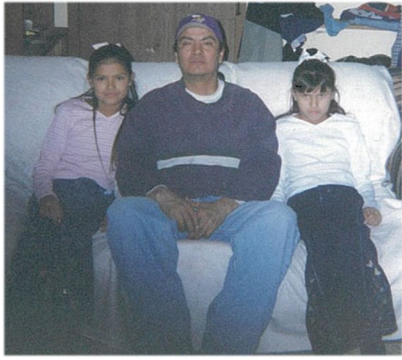
